

Children's Scholarship Fund of Omaha at a glance:

A Parent's Choice

CSF Omaha has no religious affiliation and is destination neutral. Families who receive a scholarship choose the school that best fits their children's needs.

A Family Commitment

Every family who receives a scholarship must contribute \$500 to their child's education, and each scholar must achieve a minimum attendance rate of 90%.

A Commitment until Graduation

Once a child receives a scholarship, they will continue to do so until 8th grade graduation.*


About CSF Omaha

CSF Omaha (CSF) is an independent not-for-profit organization that gives K-8 scholarships to children from low-income families so they can attend the private or parochial school of their choice.



CSF Success

CSF believes that being able to choose the right K-8 school builds a foundation for a student's future success.



Assessment of our program has shown that CSF students experience success in their chosen K-8 school and beyond. Approximately 99% of CSF alumni have graduated from high school, and approximately 86% have pursued some form of postsecondary education.*

Applying for a CSF Scholarship

Research private and parochial schools and determine the school that is the best fit.



Obtain an application during the application period from your desired school, or from the CSF website.



Submit a **complete** application to your desired school by the indicated deadline. Incomplete applications **cannot** be considered.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is my family eligible to receive a scholarship?

- Scholarships are based on financial need, following income guidelines similar to the National School Lunch Program. Please see the CSF website for our most recent income scale: www.csfomaha.org.

Are siblings of my CSF scholar able to receive a scholarship?

- Yes, every child in your family is eligible to receive a CSF scholarship, once they are in grades K-8.

Can I transfer my scholarship to a different private school?

- Yes, you may apply your CSF scholarship to a different private or parochial school, should you decide to transfer.

How much will my child's scholarship be?

- Current scholarship amounts range from \$400-\$1,750, and the same amount is awarded to each child in your family. Please note that a CSF scholarship does NOT cover full tuition at a private school.
