New Business

Vicki Payton discussed security. (see layout) Marty, Craig and Vicky reviewed facilities for different degrees of perspective. Looking for more cameras. One fixed at front office and one down the main corridor. The new activity center has better system. Used in neighborhood. Looking to upgrade to more cameras in schools and all entrances and exits. Looking to add more broadcasting specifically to soccer fields and basketball lot. The broadcasting will upgrade phones, as well. Asked for money, there is no money in their budget. Would have to budget out for a three year plan. Will have to do this project in more than one phase. There was much discussion on what we can do to protect our children.

**There was a motion to vote, by Anne Moeller, to use \$25000 to complete extension of cameras at church and school. Includes 3 internal fixed cameras and cameras on the east side of school. Amanda Pfeifer seconds.

**There was a motion to vote, by Melissa Krejci, to use \$18000 to do the expansion of the cameras with the 3 fixed cameras inside, but exclude the cameras on the east side of school. Sarah Scott seconded.

**There was a motion to vote, by Paula Blackledge, to use \$5300 to update and expand our PA system. Shelly Durbin seconded.

We were reminded by Alyson that this would deplete our savings.

Ann Rasmussen spoke to us about new classroom projectors. Looking for 10 projectors for K-8. This is the number one thing teachers want. They are \$1799 each. Have the company install one and Ann says she can figure out how to install the rest. They can be used with desktops and I-pads. RF could also use them.

**There was a motion to vote, by Paula Blackledge, to use \$18000 for 10 classroom projectors. Anne Moeller seconded.
