School Operations: [Jim Ridder]

Discussed drop off and pick-up challenges and potential temporary changes due to construction beyond our control. Parking and construction concerns near the fire station, beginning next week. Candace mentioned a note was going out tomorrow.

Jim sent a communication on the testing mandate. 19 States challenging it via court. Circuit court will be done via lottery. Large per incident fines for non-compliance.

Vaccine status is not protected under HIPPA for employers that meet the OSHA requirements.

Early childhood programs are not as good of a revenue source. Historically, the student teacher ratio was too high for best practices. So we lowered our ratio to be consistent with best practices and this aligns with other schools.

St. Pat's Nature Playground Vision- Candace mentioned nature playground outback to make it aesthetically appealing and encourage learning outside. Need to get approval from Parish council. Home and School expressed interest in help funding the cost. Promotes creativity.
