President's Report: [Meg Schwartz]

Finance committee reported \$46K from the fall festival and \$13k would go to curriculum for 2022-2023.

Salary increases of 3% (Approved). Tuition increase of 2%-2.5% (Not finalized). School was projecting a preliminary net loss. Pre-School budget was discussed in-depth.

Principal's Remarks:

Enrollment update- 97% retention rate for students. Reevaluated the number for best practices to ensure ratios are in-line with other schools in the area.

Facts Update

Preschool reevaluated on the ratio of teachers to students. Began to offer the all-day option for meeting the needs of the families. In addition, have not turned families away. Not enough preschool kids in the afternoon causes teachers to not have classes to teach.

Goal is to go from the current 740 students to 750 students for the 2022-2023 school year. Actively looking for new students. Actively, giving tours to help promote the school and related benefits.

Amendment to the 2022-2023 school calendar for Presidents Day off. Took early out off in February.

State of the School- April 21<sup>st</sup> live session @ 7PM. SAB will attend and test scores will be openly discussed. In addition, GAP campaign and other marketing materials will be discussed.

Step It Up – March 28<sup>th</sup> is the kick-off. Offered to help raise funds. Kids are tasked to raising funds from friends and family. Big party at the end of the fundraiser for all the kids with a fun day (Day of Awesomeness) at soccer field. No selling anything just fundraising. Kids provide 5-10 names and Happy Foster handles all of the solicitation. St. Pats would get a portion of the funds.

Pastor's Remarks:

Father Tom appreciated the opportunity to give Confirmation. Blessed with many RF families. Roughly 150 kids confirmed throughout two ceremonies. Bishop may restructure going forward.

First Communion is scheduled for May 1st. Splitting between 5 different times.
