A-Z Summer Direct Reading instruction for students entering 1st or 2nd grade in 2022-2023- A-Z

Reading encompasses the same three basic areas included in most good reading programs: decoding, writing, and comprehension. The emphasis in grades K-3 is on systematic phonics (step by step) "learning how to read." The method uses a multisensory approach ("seeing", "hearing", and "feeling".) The multisensory techniques compensate for memory problems and allow the student to learn through experiencing the instruction as well as hearing and seeing This reading program provides consistency throughout the summer for your emerging reader and writer. **It is a 5-week program meeting 3 times week.
