Principal's Report

Summer pandemic planning

Academic team met weekly. Teachers who excelled in the spring with eLearning were asked to serve on committee and share best practices. Large focus on enhancing back up plans should in-person learning be interrupted.

Safety committee coordinated the efforts to open the school for the fall.

CARES Act Money

St. Pat's received \$7600 – Electrostatic sprayers and Seesaw subscription was purchased. St. Pat's also received \$8000 in donations which was used to purchase fanny packs, plexiglass installation supplies, professional development for staff and online subscriptions.

Professional Development for Staff

During June/July, 47 faculty members completed 281 hours of professional development (approximately 6 hours each) in maximizing the use of FACTS, Seesaw, and Choice.

How has the pandemic effected enrollment?

Enrollment is down slightly. 778 total students. 7 families (15 kids) are using extended absence process for learning. 4 families (8 kids) have opted for home school and will return when the learning and/or health environment becomes normalized.
