President's Report:

- Strategic Planning Reflection - went well. Question brought up as we get closer to finalizing plan with cost, are we still shooting for the moon vs. reality. Principal's Report

- **2025 Scholarship Recipients:** 35% of 8th grade class earned a scholarship (4 Marian, 1 Prep, 1 Roncalli, 9 Skutt, 4 Mount Michael, and 5 Duchesne)
- **Budget for 2025-26:** Requested a 3% increase to base pay, along with longevity pay, requested increase to support staff to be respectfully paid.
- **Renovation update:** private donor came forward to cover remaining goal from raise the paddle (office renovation) for classrooms, we will continue with flooring contractor, but for the walls, 2 other bids came in lower.
- **Reenrollment Update:** 749, with expecting still to reenroll, 774, additional 10 students admin working with to enroll
- **Staffing Updates:** Ann Menning and Deb Brown resigning, looking at candidates to fill their positions
- **25th Celebration:** Candace shared week of events, including commemorative t-shirts for all staff and student with option for parents to purchase. 3/16-3/21
- **Weather Related Decisions:** options are to follow Elkhorn Public Schools or Omaha Catholic. Agreed to continue to follow Elkhorn Public Schools for weather related decisions. 4 days are built in, 5th weather related closing would be remote learning
