- ❖ Miss Mumm- Courage and Kindness Retreats-
 - Miss Mumm attended the meeting to ask for funds for these retreats. This will be the 8th year the school has done the courage retreat for 7th grade. Added the kindness retreat for 4th graders 2 years ago. It has been well recieved. Described as a condensed summer camp. They are full day events.
 - It is put on by a company out of Minneapolis. Due to travel, the retreat is on the more expensive side. Cost is \$7650 for both retreats. Miss Mumm feels they are well worth the money. School has already paid deposit. Last year H&S was able to fund 100%.

 - Anne Moeller motioned to amend H&S budget to add retreat as line item for future years
 - Jessi Sallenbach seconded both motionswill vote at November meeting.
 - Retreats have been scheduled. Courage Retreat January 17, 2025. Kindness Retreat April 4, 2025.
- ❖ Kami Landenberger-
 - School Renovation Projects- Made possible with the profits from Shamrock Stride. There is curling wallpaper and stained carpets in the 3rd and 4th grade hallway. Also, rooms directly below those most in need of renovations. These are the oldest rooms. Will be getting bids this Friday. Hope for renovations to happen over the summer.

- Textbooks- language arts textbooks, the loan with the state greatly streamlined, now it is run state level instead of district level, there are more texts to choose from. Working on needs and language arts is always a big purchase, around \$75k+, loan was \$35k last year. Working on bids based on needs.
- Can H&S earmark this on budget? 30% of fall festival revenue already goes towards curriculum.
