2029: Replace 15 guitars (\$1,600+)

2030: Replace elementary instruments, full sized keyboards (\$2,000+)

2031: Replace 15 guitars (\$2,000+)

- ❖ Kami Landenberger would like to use 30% of the fall festival proceeds, \$12,500 to complete the playground set.
