Opportunity Scholarship Nebraska Petition Recap-- Senator LouAnn Linehan came to campus and met with a handful of parishioners and parents to debunk myths about the OSN program and help spread the news of this program and how it can impact our communities and grow enrollment at our Catholic Schools. To date, \$600,000 has been raised with priests and religious people having donated the most. Handouts and marketing information were left for the school to disseminate to new families.

Enrollment Update

We are at 751 and we are still touring families and we have 13 current students who have not yet re-enrolled. We are on target to meet the goal of having 755 enrolled for the '24-'25 school year.
