## **Principal's Report**

### Faith Formation

School Mass – one grade at a time attends mass weekly in the church while the rest participate via zoom. K-4 have mass on Tuesdays and middle school is on Wednesdays.

Day of Eucharistic Adoration – on 9/2 Jesus is Coming visited each classroom.

33 Days of Consecration of Mary – kicked off on 9/4 and will include morning prayer, music video, daily examination and will conclude on 10/7 on the Feast of the Holy Rosary.

Father Moser visits every classroom each month.

### COVID-19 Update

August – 1 positive case, 6 (5 students, 1 staff) quarantined = 7 students and staff out  
September MTD – 0 positive cases, 5 (4 students, 1 staff) quarantined = 5 students and staff out

### STARS Testing

STARS has taken the place of MAPS and Terra Nova

Focus is on what the student knows so that appropriate learning plans can be developed for the individual child. Tests are shorter so there is less time testing and more time learning. Assessments in early literacy, math, and subjects of teacher's choice occurred in September and are scheduled for October 12-15, and December 7-11.

### Updates

PBIS (Postive Behavior Intervention System) – this is the new behavior framework that is being implemented throughout the school. HALOs have been implemented as a reward system for the whole school. Each classroom is utilizing their own behavior management system. 5th - 8th is still utilizing merits and demerits in the classroom in addition to HALOs. PBIS has been well received with kids receiving “Halos” for displaying behavior or actions that Respects God, Others, Self & Things. Every Friday, prizes are drawn with the names of all the kids receiving halos.

Library – kids will start going to the library on 9/14.
