Unfinished Business

Principal's Report

- Shamrock Stride is off to a good start, \$39,400 raised and 422 of 451 families have participated thus far.
- Star Testing numbers show an increase for our students
 - We are back on track to apply for Blue Ribbon Status with some of the best scores in recent years. Data collection begins with 3rd Grade.
- Goal has been set to have all students reading at or above their grade level.
- 3% enrollment growth this school year and Early Childhood is full.
- HAL Program
 - 4th year of the program served 3rd-5th grade Math with Mrs. Peal.
